The Morton & Hanthorpe Parish Council has and is:

- Supporting the M&H Coronavirus Support Team - with supplies such as gloves, stationary etc..
- Designed, composed, printed and provided badges & forms insuring that the forms/volunteers were/are GDPR compliant.
- Ordered more gloves and thin 'poly-bags' as gloves are in short supply! These can be used as mittens.
- Have been and are in liaison with the various bodies and emergency groups throughout Lincolnshire including the main Lincolnshire Resilience Team.
- Provided and complied with information & survey requests from a number of these bodies.
- Set awareness and advice notices at a number of locations within the Parish - again which we have prepared and funded. Hazard taped play equipment with warnings to stop their use and the possible spread of infection.
- Provided the local policing board with information.
- Provided a contact point (telephone & e-mail) for concerned parishioners or those with queries (over 100 so far) - pointing them to the appropriate advice /help.

Whilst undertaking the above the Council has continued to administer the day-to-day business of the parish council whilst having to find innovative ways to do this - voting through e-mail, internet payment of cheques, time dependent grass cutting, tree pruning, Planning & Highways proposals etc. whilst maintaining legal compliance throughout.
